Whereas, Mr. Arees Zargar (Draftsman Civil) approached the Chief Engineer, Public Health Engineering Kashmir through application for grant of study leave/ leave which ever applicable to him as per Civil Service Rules; and

Whereas, the Chief Engineer, Public Health Engineering Kashmir vide his letter No. PHE/Estt/32935 dated 01.12.2022 forwarded the application of the official to the Administrative department for consideration as per rules, and

Whereas; on examination of the case it has been found that Mr. Arees Zargar has been appointed as Draftsman (Civil) vide Government order No. 185-JK (JSD) of 2022 dated 25.08.2022 and is still on probation and has to complete more than five years of service in the department in order to attain eligibility under rules as the General Administration Department vide Circular No. 49-JK (GAD) of 2022 dated 07.12.2022, inter- alia reiterated that the study leave shall not ordinarily be granted to a Government employee who has rendered less than five years service under the Government; and

Whereas, Sub rules (1) and (4) of Rule 61 of J&K Civil Service (Leave) Rules 1979 inter alia provides as under:-

"Sub rule (1) Study leave may be granted to a Government servant with due regard to the exigencies of public service to enable him to undergo in or out of India a special course of study consisting of higher studies or specialized training in a professional or technical subject having a direct and close connection with sphere of his duty.

Sub Rule (4) Study leave shall not ordinarily be granted to a Government servant, who has rendered less than three year's service under the Government or till he/she, if probationer, does not complete the period of probation satisfactorily whichever is later."



Now, therefore, taking note of the above rule position, the request of the official has been found devoid of any merit and is hereby rejected.


