Whereas, department is in receipt of a copy of representation from the petitioner namely Sh. Raj Kumar Chalotra seeking implementation of the order dated 10.02.2025 passed in TA No. 6427/2020 titled Raj Kumar Chalotra and Ors VS UT of J&K and Ors as per the direction of the Hon'ble Central Administrative Tribunal (CAT), Jammu Bench; and

2. Whereas, Hon'ble CAT Jammu Bench vide order dated 10.02.2025 has disposed of the case with the following directions, the operative portion of which reads as under:-

"Accordingly, the Transferred Application is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to consider the case of the petitioners on the analogy of judgment rendered by the Hon'ble High Court of Jammu and Kashmir, at Jammu, in the case titled Bishan Dutt Chargotra Vs State of J&K bearing SWP No. 926/1995 dated 18.03.1996 and if the petitioner is found to be similarly situated of the petitioner in judgment dated 18.03.1996, then the similar relief would be granted to the petitioners herein.

Respondents are further directed to communicate the order so passed to the petitioners. The whole exercise shall be undertaken within a period of six weeks, from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

With these directions, this Transferred Application is disposed of. It is made clear that, we have not entered into the merits of the case."

- 3. Whereas, among others, Shri Raj Kumar Chalotra and Shri Shiv Kumar were initially appointed as 'Sectional Officers' (Civil) in the grade of Rs 340-700 vide Government Order No.PW-136 of 1978 dated 22.03.1978 figuring at S.No.13 and 14 respectively in the aforesaid Government Order; and
- Whereas, the Petitioners acquired/ passed AMIE Section (A&B) Course on 06.10.1994 and 08.04.1994 respectively and on the aforesaid basis, their seniority was fixed as Junior Engineers (Degree Holders) from the date of passing of their Degrees. The details are given as under:-

- Whereas, a proposal regarding regularization/promotion of 469 Junior Engineers as 5. Assistant Engineers (Degree Holders) (Civil) was referred to the PSC for placing the same before the DPC of PSC for consideration, including Shri Raj Kumar Chalotra and Shri Shiv Kumar. A meeting of the DPC/PSC was held in the J&K Public Service Commission on 07.02.2023 at 4:00 P.M followed by wrap-up discussions held on 13.04.2023; and
- Whereas, in the aforesaid meeting, DPC also considered, regular promotion of Shri Raj Kumar Chalotra and Shri Shiv Kumar as AEs with effect from 12.05.2011 and 15.07.2011 respectively, subject to fresh Vigilance clearances. However, the fresh Vigilance Clearances of these officers have not been received in the department so far.

Now, therefore, the claim of the petitioner has been considered with due deference to the order dated 10.02.2025 passed by the Hon'ble Central Administrative Tribunal's Bench Jammu in T.A. No. 642/2020 titled Raj Kumar Chalotra and Shri Shiv Kumar Vs UT of J&K and Ors have been found devoid of any merit for the aforesaid reasons and is accordingly rejected.
