Whereas, on the recommendations of the Service Selection Board, J&K, Sh. Whereas, Rule 21(1) of J&K Services (Classification, Control & Appeal), Rules 1956, provides as under:-

b) at his discretion terminate the probation of a probationer and discharge him from service.




