Whereas, the objections/representations so received were examined in the Department and considered in light of Rule 24 of J&K Civil Service (Classification, Control and Appeal) Rules, 1956.

Accordingly, vide this department's letter dated 22.06.2021, PSC has been requested to place the case of the officer for release of his sealed cover promotion/regularization as Executive Engineer before the DPC/PSC, as the charges leveled against the said officer has been dropped vide Govt. Order No. 99-JK (JSD) of 2021 dated 30.04.2021.</p> <p>The name of the officer shall be included in the seniority list of the Executive Engineer at appropriate place after his regularization as Executive Engineer is cleared by the DPC/PSC. His case has been cleared by the DPC/PSC. However, after receiving the recommendation from PSC, it has been observed that among others, Shri Iftikhar Ahmad Wani, the then I/c Executive Engineer, PHE Division Handwara was placed under suspension vide Government Order 145-PW (Hyd) of 2016 dated 31.05.2016. Subsequently, vide Govt. Order No. 106-PW (Hyd) of 2018 dated 08.03.2018, the officer has been re-instated with immediate effect and his intervening period of suspension shall be decided after conclusion of departmental proceeding. The intervening period of the suspension of the officer is yet to be settled.</p> <p>The case has been examined in the department accordingly the competent authority has decided to withhold the regularization/promotion of the officer as Executive Engineer, till such time his intervening period of suspension is decided, on the same analogy as has been done by the DPC/PSC in case of Shri Qazi Mushtaq, as Shri Iftikhar Ahmad Wani the then I/c Executive Engineer PHE Division Handwara, is also involved in the instant case.</p>


