Sanction is hereby accorded to the temporary appointment of Mr. Umer Gani Sheikh S/o: Late Abdul Gani Sheikh R/o: Ikhranjpora Tehsil Srinagar North, District, Srinagar as Sweeper (Class-IV), in the Pay Level of SL-1 (14800-47100), in PHE Department, Kashmir, in relaxation of the prescribed qualification bar in terms of Rule- 7 of SRO-43 of 1994.

The appointee shall report to Chief Engineer, PHE Department, Kashmir within a period of 21 days from the date of issuance of this order and shall be allowed to join only on production of the following documents/certificates (in original) to be verified subsequently:-

- i. Academic qualification certificate.
- ii. Date of Birth Certificate.
- iii. Domicile certificate
- iv. Health Certificate from the concerned Chief Medical Officer of the District
- v. Dependent Certificate issued by the Assistant Commissioner, Revenue.
- vi. No loan Certificate under self Employment Scheme from DIC concerned and Employment Department.
- vii. All other relevant documents as are required under SRO-43/1994.

The appointment of the appointee shall further be subject to the following conditions:-

(a). That he shall give an undertaking in the shape of an Affidavit to the effect that:-

- (i). In case adverse report about his Character and Antecedents is received from the Inspector General of Police, (CID), J&K, to whom a reference shall be made by the PHE Department, he shall be have no right to claim his appointment as Sweeper in J&K Engineering (Subordinate) Services and his appointment, as such, shall be deemed to have been cancelled ab-initio;
- (ii). If, on verification, genuineness of the qualification certificates from the concerned issuing authority is found fake/ forged, the claim of the appointee for appointment as Sweeper shall also be deemed to have been cancelled ab-initio and the legal action as warranted under rules shall be initiated against him.

- (f) The salary of the appointee shall not be drawn and disbursed unless his satisfactory report in respect of (i) and (ii) above are received in his favour.
- (g) The appointee shall be initially on probation for a period of two years.
- (h) The appointment of the candidate shall be governed by the "New Pension Scheme" as per SRO- 400 of 2009 dated 24.12.2009
- (i) If the appointee fails to join within a period of 21 (twenty one) days from the date of issuance of this order he shall forego his right to appointment which shall be deemed to have been cancelled ab-initio without any further notice.
